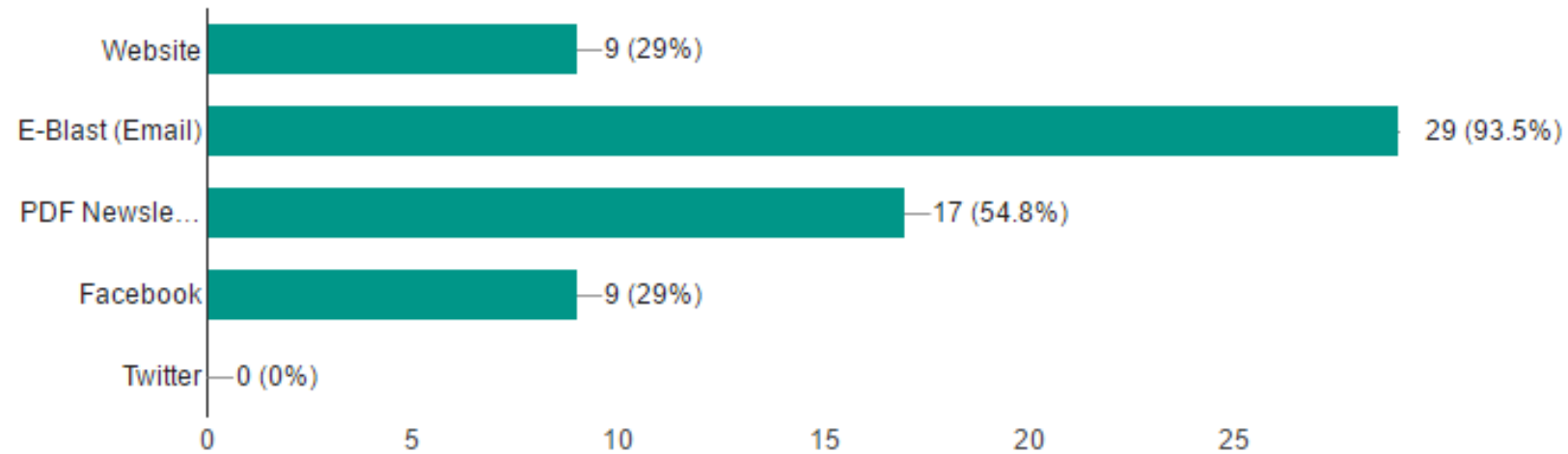

Communication Preferences

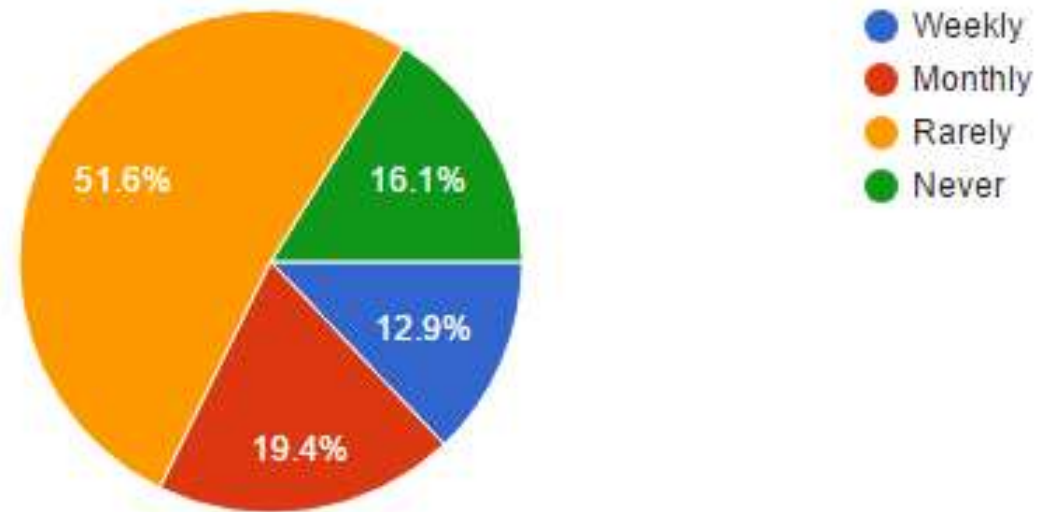
What are your preferred means of communication from our branch? (Check all that apply)

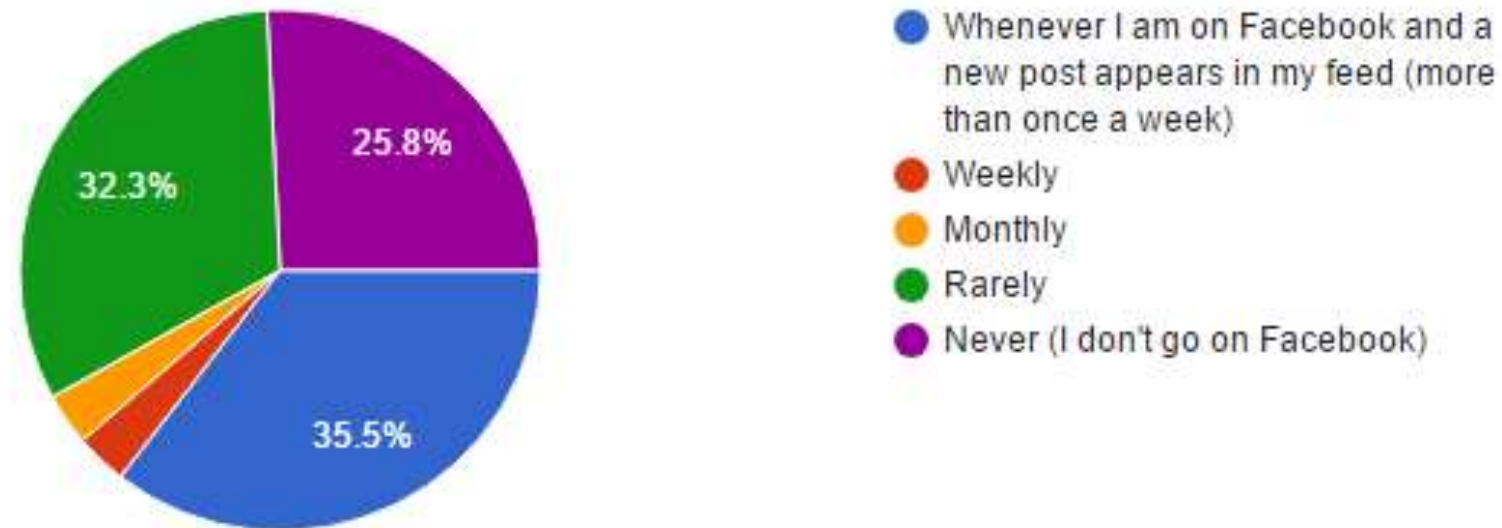
Communication – Website use

How often do you visit our website? (31 responses)



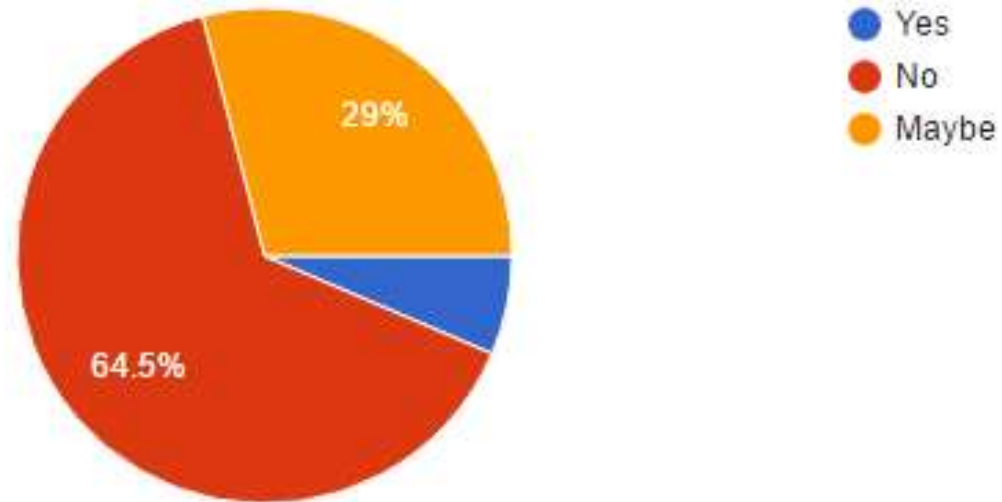
Communication - Facebook

Would you follow us on Twitter? (31 responses)

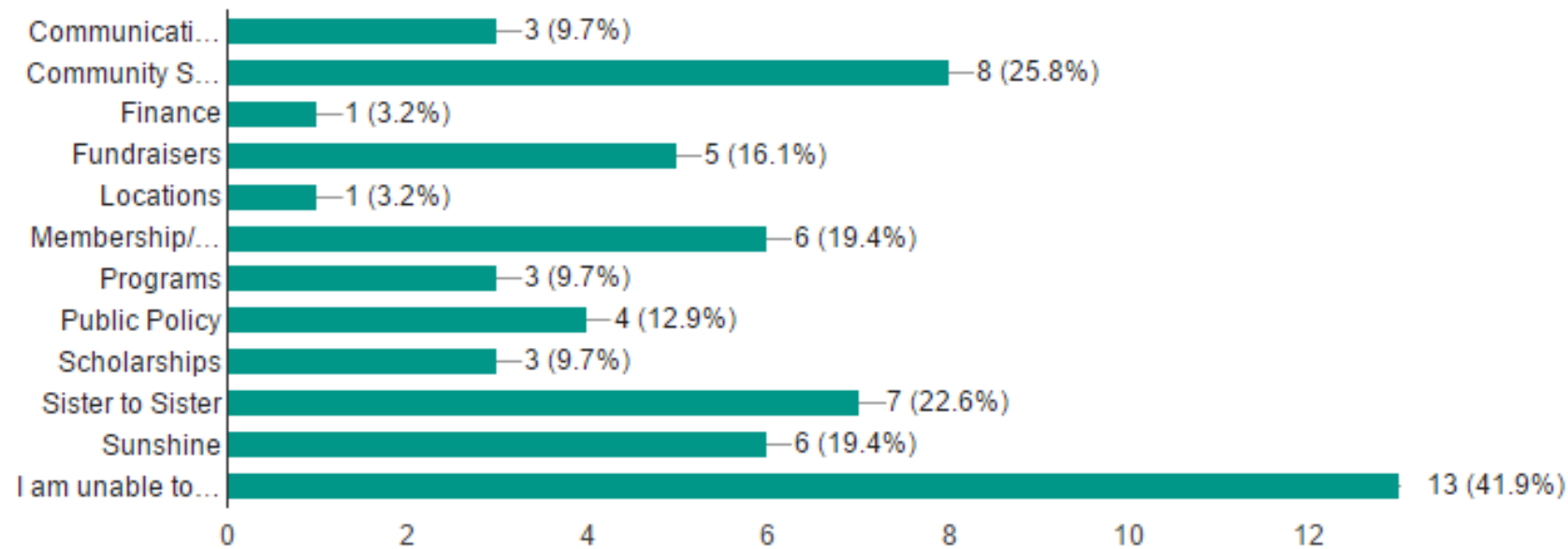

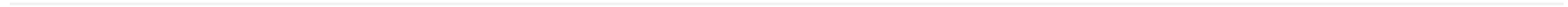
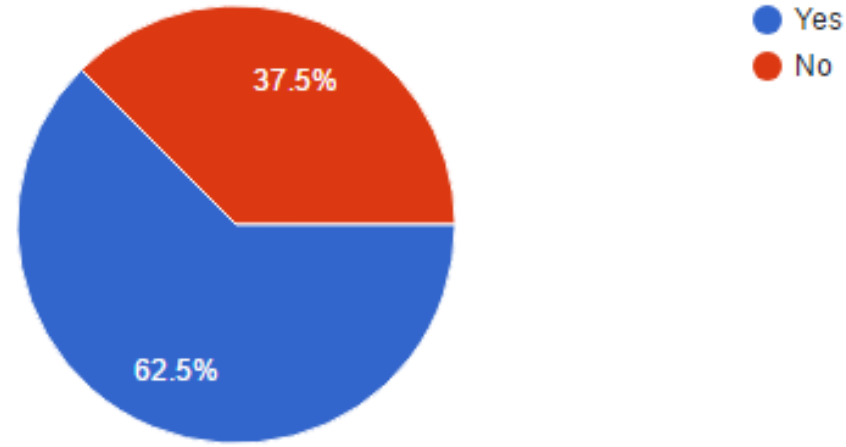
On which committee(s) are you willing to serve (next year)? (31 responses)

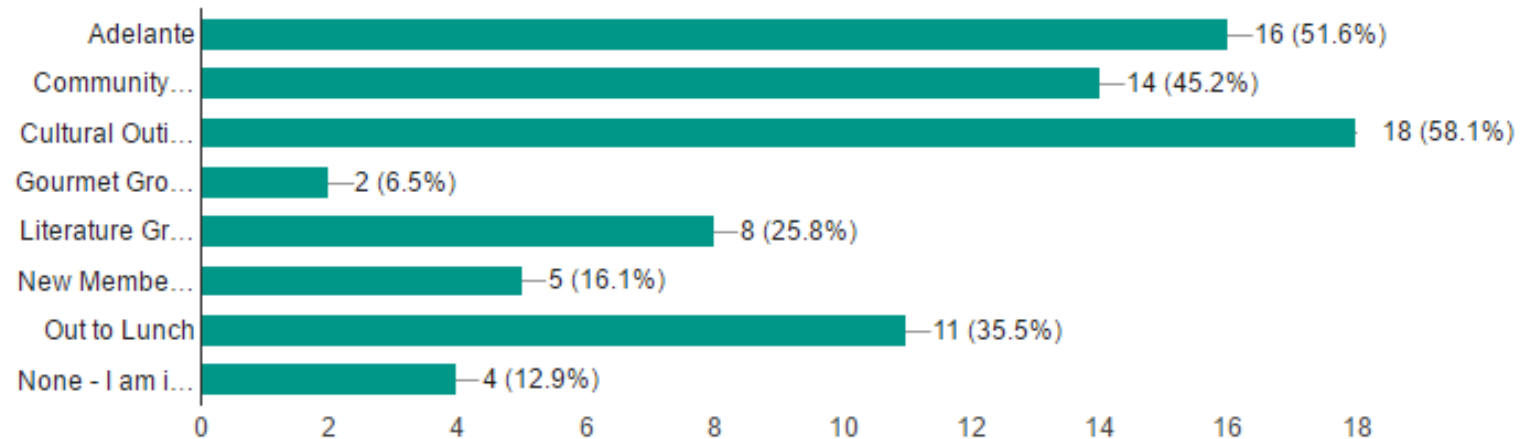

In which of our interest groups do you like to participate? (Check all that apply)

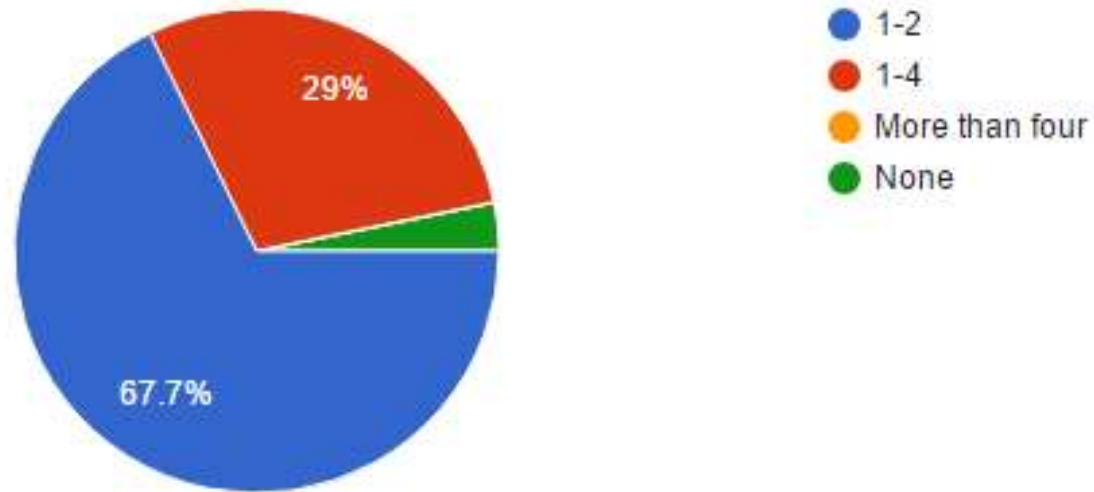
